## IV. Statement of Christian Faith

Grand Rapids Baptist Seminary seeks students who demonstrate commitment to Jesus Christ and evidence the new birth. The following statements are from section one of the Cornerstone Confession and must be affirmed as a prerequisite for enrollment, admission to degree programs, and graduation:

We believe that the Bible is the Word of God, truth without error, clear and powerful in its message, sufficient for all of our needs, and the final authority for faith and life.

We believe that the triune God has provided a great salvation for those who repent of their sins and trust Christ and his finished work; that he calls, regenerates, justifies, forgives, adopts, sanctifies, keeps and will glorify them.

We believe in the Holy Spirit who has been sent to complete and perfect in us all the works that Jesus did for us. He convicts of sin, regenerates, sanctifies us, gifts us for ministry and assures us of our salvation.

We believe in the personal return of the Lord Jesus Christ, the bodily resurrection and final judgment of the just and the unjust, the everlasting blessedness of the saved and the everlasting, conscious punishment of the lost.

## V. Standard of Conduct

Because the reputation of the school depends on the testimony of its students, we limit enrollment to those who seek to live in conformity with the teaching of Scripture and to fulfill their responsibilities as students and Christians.
