Tuition Deposit:	\$250 due by May 8, 2009 with the reservation form (<i>non-refundable after June 1</i>). Note: The tuition deposit is applied against the tuition balance.

Payment: \$653 per month. This amount may vary if you include summer housing costs on the plan or if you receive financial aid.

- **Financial Aid** The MA TESOL program is eligible for both the Federal Stafford Loan and possibly the Michigan Tuition Grant (MTG). Eligibility is determined by completing the FAFSA which can be accessed at www.fafsa.ed.gov.
Note: The FAFSA must be completed each year. To be considered for MTG, please complete a FAFSA by April 1.

Payment amount: \$6,185
- **FACTS Payment plan**
Payment dates: 5th of each month June 2010 through March 2011
Payment: \$618.50 per month. This amount may vary if you include summer housing costs on the plan or if you receive financial aid.
Plan fee: \$50
Enrollment: To enroll in the payment plan, go to www.cornerstone.edu/goto/student_payments.
- **Financial Aid** Eligibility will be determined after you complete a FAFSA for 2010/2011. FAFSA's can be completed beginning January 1, 2010. To be considered for MTG, please complete a FAFSA by April 1.

Refund information: Refund of tuition is made on the basis of classes completed in the respective course at the time a student is withdrawn or has notified the PGS Office that he/she is withdrawing. A student will be charged again for any course that is retaken.

Students who withdraw:	Will be Refunded
• Before the 2 nd class of a course.....	100%
• After the 2 nd class, but before the midpoint of the course.....	50%
• After the midpoint of the course.....	0%
