



Peer-Reviewed (Refereed, Reviewed) Journals

(Biology Emphasis)

To Find if a Journal is Peer-Reviewed

- From the Miller Library web site (<http://www.cornerstone.edu/library>)
- Select **Search the Library Catalog** under the **Find Books & More** section
- Select **Resource Name** from the pull-down search menu and enter **Ulrich's Periodical Directory**
- Select **Title (Exact)** and enter the journal title
- In the **Features** column, check **Refereed**
- From the results screen, look for the **Refereed** symbol (TR)




To Find Miller Library Journal Holdings (if you already have a reference)

- From the Miller Library web site (<http://www.cornerstone.edu/library>)
- Select **Search the Library Catalog** under the **Find Books & More** section
- Select **Journal Title** from the pull-down search menu
- Enter the journal title
- Look for the **Lib. Has** and **Link** information

To Find Peer-Reviewed Journals in Gale Powersearch

- From the Miller Library web site (<http://www.cornerstone.edu/library>)
- Select **Search the Library Catalog** under the **Find Books & More** section
- Select **Resource Name** from the pull-down search menu and enter **Gale Powersearch**
- Click on the link
- Check the **<Select All>** and **Continue**
 - o Enter your subject terms - climate change or intelligent design
 - o Select the + to open subject subdivisions
 - o Select the subheading of your choice and then select the **Academic Journals** tab
 - o Further narrow your search by checking the **peer-reviewed** box
 - o Use your subject in an **Advanced Search**

To Find Peer-Reviewed Journals Using FirstSearch

- Go to the Miller Library web site (<http://www.cornerstone.edu/library>)
- Select **Search the Library Catalog** under the **Find Books & More** section
- Select **Resource Name** from the pull-down search menu and enter **FirstSearch**
- Click on the link
- Using the pull-down menu by **Jump to Advanced Search**, select **Wilson Select Plus**.
 - o Enter your search using keyword and/or subject indexes – Subjects are Climate and Intelligent Design Theory
 - o Set the **Limit to** box to :
 - **Reviewed Journal Phrase – Peer Reviewed**
 - o Set the **Rank by** box to **Relevance**
 - o Select **Search**
 - o Select an item to view by clicking on a highlighted title
 - o Selected multiple items to view by **Marking** the records
 - o If an item is in Miller Library,  appears; if in area libraries,  appears
 - o If an item is available in full text,  appears
 - o To view library holdings, select **Libraries Worldwide**
- Repeat the search by using **ATLAReligion** or **EducationAbs** or **ERIC** by selecting the **Searching** tab
 - o Set the **Limit to** boxes to:
 - **Peer-Reviewed – Yes**
 - o Set the **Rank by** box to **Relevance**
 - o Select **Search**
- Repeat the search by using **GenSciAbs** by selecting the **Searching** tab
 - o When back at the **Search Screen**, select **GenSciAbs** from the **Search in database** box
 - o To search for **Peer-Reviewed** articles in **GenSciAbs**, one must select one of the search boxes and enter **peer-reviewed journal** and select **Reviewed Journal Phrase** from the pull-down menu
 - o Set the **Rank by** box to **Relevance**
 - o Select **Search**
- One may mark articles in both of these databases and then view all of the marked articles by selecting **Marked Records** under the **Results** tab
- One may select to print, e-mail, or export to Ref Works any citations or articles. If an item is unavailable through Miller Library, one may request the article through InterLibrary Loan

- From the Miller Library web site (<http://www.cornerstone.edu/library>)
- Select **Search the Library Catalog** under the **Find Books & More** section
- Select **Resource Name** from the pull-down search menu and enter the name of the collection you want to search
 - o ABI Inform
 - o Wiley Blackwell
 - o Science Direct journals
 - o JSTOR
 - o Sage Collections

CQ Researcher

- From the Miller Library web site (<http://www.cornerstone.edu/library>)
- Select **Search the Library Catalog** under the **Find Books & More** section
- Select **Resource Name** from the pull-down search menu and enter the name **CQ Researcher**
- In the Quick Search box, enter <climate change> or <intelligent design>
- Select a Report to view

Issues & Controversies

- From the Miller Library web site (<http://www.cornerstone.edu/library>)
- Select **Resource Name** from the pull-down search menu and enter the name **Issues & Controversies**
- Enter <global warming> or <intelligent design> in the search box

Opposing Viewpoints

- From the Miller Library web site (<http://www.cornerstone.edu/library>)
- Select **Resource Name** from the pull-down search menu and enter the name **Opposing Viewpoints**
- Select <Global Warming> from the list of topics
- For **Intelligent Design** do a basic search
