



SEARCHING WITHIN THE WALL STREET JOURNAL

ACCESSING THE WALL STREET JOURNAL

1. Go to Miller Library's Homepage (www.cornerstone.edu/library)
2. Click on Journals List under the Research Tools column
3. Type in Wall Street Journal
4. Select Wall Street Journal. Eastern edition from 01/02/1984 to present in [ABI/INFORM Global](#). Click the hyperlink ABI Inform Global
5. You are then able to browse by specific date or you may click on the Searching Within Publication to search the indexed issues of Wall Street Journal

SEARCHING WITHIN A SPECIFIC SECTION

1. To search a specific section (international, marketplace, etc) of a newspaper like the Wall Street Journal on ABI Inform, access ABI Inform from Miller Library's databases page
2. Click on the Advanced Search tab
3. In the 1st search box type sec(Section Name)
 - Place the name of the section in ()
 - Example: sec(international)
4. In the 2nd search box, select publication title from the drop down menu and browse the publications list for Wall Street Journal
5. In the 3rd search box: type in search terms. Click add a row to add additional search terms (See screen shot below.)

According to an ABI Inform representative, sometimes section of newspapers are indexed as columns, if that is the case, type col(name of column of newspaper you would like to search in)
